Since January 2013, our calling and desire has always been to see healthy and sound churches, led by pastors who are trained by the "whole counsel of God" able and willing to teach through the Bible, verse by verse. Mindful of the great need in unreached people groups (UPG), we have been blessed to establish pastors among two UPG's - one in Sierra Leone, one in Ghana. While both face significant challenges, reports of the increased faith of believers among these people groups is very encouraging!

Since 2013, WAMMP has sent 12 young men to Bible Training in Ghana, with four more waiting to go soon. Blessings, all! Six solid churches have been established in Sierra Leone! The adult literacy program has been crucial to those seeking a better life and the substance abuse recovery program has literally brought many from the brink of death. Soon, we plan to join with our ministry partner in Nigeria to incorporate a robust community development program within our outreaches.

5 strategies for ministry growth

Bible Training

With so many young West African men experiencing solid and steadfast faith for themselves, their families, and their communities, the need for more trained pastors increases. Literally dozens are asking for this training!

Church Planting/ Outreach

With remarkable conviction and faith, churches are planted that then go out to surrounding villages with The JESUS Film and share the gospel with others. The response is profound, sometimes entire villages surrender to Jesus! We need to get pastors trained for those village areas, and soon!

Adult Literacy

With the illiteracy rate at about 70-80%, especially among women, our heart is to bring the joy of reading to these adults by using the Bible as our "textbook". It's been highly effective and life-changing!

Recovery Program

With a horrific drug infiltrating the lives of young people in Sierra Leone called "Kush", we sought to impact the lives of these substance abusers for Jesus and introduced "One Step to Freedom" to address addictive drugs and idolatries.

Community Development

With poverty and infectious diseases still rampant, compounded by a lack of access to decent medical care, we seek to partner with a proven program that teaches villagers to recognize their problems and teaches them how to improve village life with their own resources.

Since 2008, our hearts have been drawn towards the people of West Africa, especially the remarkable people of Sierra Leone. Our exploratory trip in Jan 2013 cemented our calling and we continue to partner now with most of those we met in Sierra Leone in 2013.

In 2016, we launched a nonprofit, West Africa Mission Mobilization Project, in order to bring others alongside this beautiful work that God is doing in, and through, the people of West Africa!

Hedges of Mercy, Nigeria

Many of you have been instrumental in seeing that the Safe Haven compound would be completed. It is now filled with joyful girls being raised up in the love of Jesus Christ through the Safe Haven staff.

The mission field has been a much more difficult endeavor as persecutions occur far too often, with officials seeming to turn a blind eye to all the violence inflicted on Christian villages. But God... through Whom boldness and an unwavering courage in continuing to bring the Gospel message persists among the Nigerian missionaries. Pastors and Ministry Leaders Conference

Looking ahead to Feb 2026, we plan to hold another Leadership Conference in Sierra Leone's Western Peninsula. We anticipate speakers from Sierra Leone, Ghana, Nigeria, and the United States will encourage and edify those in ministry as well as those invited by their pastors to attend. Pastor Desmond, Ghana

As we encouraged Pastor Desmond to see the nearby Fulani encampments as a mission field, he then began meeting weekly with them. Many have now come to Jesus in faith and are sending their children to the village Christian school.

Calvary Bible Training Centers in Ghana

Teaching the Word of God began simply in Sierra Leone. Two young men agreed to read, verse by verse, and ask if those gathered understood. These fellowships grew and we recognized the need for sound Bible training for these, and other young men. We were invited to send selected young men to Ghana for training where they not only learned the entire Bible but also the importance of outreaches. In recent years, a second Bible Training center in Ghana offered availability to our students. We currently have two young men there who express such gratitude for this opportunity and for how their hearts and minds have come to understand God's purpose for those who are yearning to serve Him.

- **Mohamed** comes from an unreached people in the NE corner of Sierra Leone. His pastor, Sheku, trained in Ghana in 2017 and recommended Mohamed for training. He will return soon to partner with Pastor Sheku in outreaches to the surrounding communities, nearly all of whom have never even heard the name of Jesus.

- **Moses** is from Kambia District, a region that has been asking for a pastor for several years. He was motivated to be sent to Ghana after an outreach to a nearby muslim village resulted in all present seeking to live for Jesus.

Its primary purpose is to equip missions in West Africa

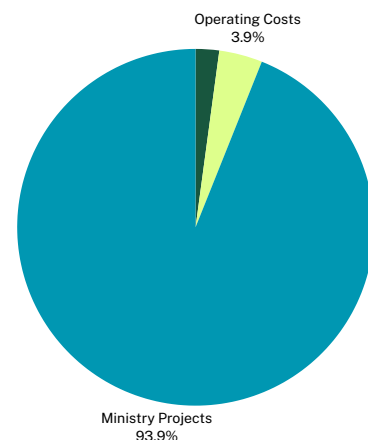
INTRODUCTION

STRATEGY SOURCES

- Pastoral Training and Discipleship:** Calvary West Africa Bible Institute (CWABI) in Ghana and Calvary Bible Training Center, also in Ghana. Training in Nigeria through Hedges of Mercy (HoM)/ Mac Phillips
- Church Planting and Outreach:** Calvary Chapel Distinctives in agreement with the Calvary Chapel Association of Churches (CCA) & The JESUS Film.
- Adult Literacy Program:** Developed by California educator, Robert Koller, the program is used by WAMMP with the Bible as its "textbook".
- Substance Abuse Recovery Program:** One Step to Freedom (OSTF) - a 51-week Bible- based study addressing addiction and other idolatries. Endorsed by Pastor Chuck Smith, Calvary Chapel founder
- Community Development:** In early 2026, we plan to send a young man for an internship under Mac Phillips in Nigeria to learn and implement the program "Viable Community Initiatives" upon his return to Sierra Leone.
