The widows... whose lives have been torn apart by pain, anguish, loss, and everything in between... these are the mothers of the rescued girls.

*Invited by Hedges of Mercy to reunite with their daughters, themselves victims of kidnaps and major Fulani attacks. We realized very quickly that their anguish was deeper than we ever thought or imagined; this pain had settled into their bones. Safe Haven will host 3 more trauma care sessions in 2026.*
